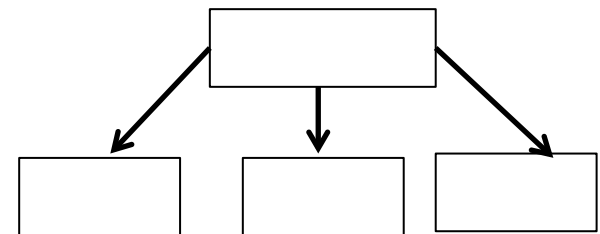


Instructions:

3. Insert more popples to create a main idea chart that shows details that support the main idea.

2. Open Kidblog.
3. Click "New Post."
4. Title your post "**Summary- A New Way to Play.**" Type your summary (following the main idea and detail chart you thought about previously).

Vocabulary



Goal: I can use context clues to determine word meanings in stories that I read. I can also use antonyms and synonyms to describe how different words are related.

Instructions:

1. Read through the passage and locate the following words
 - a. Ordinary (par. 1)
 - b. access (par 6)
2. Open the app: BOOK CREATOR
3. In the upper right corner, click NEW BOOK then LANDSCAPE
4. Create a cover page. Include the title of the passage, the author of the passage, and your name.
5. On the next page, enter the 1st vocabulary word. Every new page will have a different vocabulary word on it.
6. Every page must have:
 - The vocabulary word
 - Definition of the word
 - The vocabulary word used in a sentence (not from the passage)
 - Illustration
 - Synonym and/or Antonym of the word

Vocabulary
